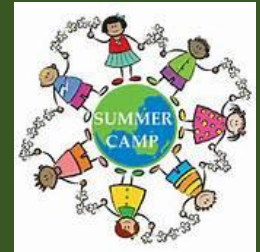

## VT Green Mountain Conservation Camp—Buck Lake, Woodbury, Vermont



### Week-Long Basic Camp for Youth Ages 12-14

Cost: \$250

Green Mountain Conservation Camp (GMCC) offers hands-on learning experiences about fish, wildlife, ecology, botany, forestry, hunter firearm safety, outdoor first aid, and so much more! Wildlife education and outdoor skills are the focus of GMCC and the program's goal is to cultivate a caring attitude among our youth for Vermont's fish and wildlife resources. GMCC offers opportunity for hiking, canoeing, fishing, archery, .22 rifle and shotgun shooting, orienteering and other fun activities. Vermont's conservation camp program is unique because it is sponsored and directed by Fish & Wildlife Department professionals—the same people who manage the fish and wildlife resources. Working biologists, foresters, game wardens, and conservation educators teach young people about Vermont's forests, wetlands, and wildlife. Youth develop valuable life skills and gain environmental knowledge so they can continue the state's traditional rural pursuits—enjoying all aspects of the outdoor world. The program's greatest strength is connecting young people to the outdoors. **Campers must first attend a basic week before they can attend an advanced week. There are separate weeks open for boys and girls. A camper must have reached their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before or during their camp week. No exceptions are made for age. Applications are taken on a first-come, first-served basis. See attached application for available dates.**

### The Natural Resources Management Academy

A special weekend for high-school students (Grades 7-12) ready to explore, in-depth, Vermont's natural Resources. At the Academy, you'll learn more about Vermont's forests, wildlife, soils and water ecology.

### Intro to Mountain Bike Day Camp

**July 3-7 | Ages: 7-11 Day Camp**

**Cost: \$700 (NEK Students \$600)**

This camp is geared towards those who are new to the wild and wonderful world of adventure by mountain bike. The camp day is shorter and individual attention helps riders conquer small and large obstacles, while benefiting from the low-pressure environment and encouragement from the group. We will practice our skills during group rides on Kingdom Trails and in the Burke Mountain Bike Park, while also leaving enough time for outdoor games, team-building challenges, and swimming. We may also begin a spontaneous game of camouflage in the woods as a way to loosen our single-track muscle and remind us of the most fundamental rule of mountain biking – it's fun!

### Mountain Bike Adventure Day Camps

## Kit and Cubs Day Camp

**August 14-18 | Ages: 3-6**

**Cost: \$300**

Join us in our brand, new Kits and Cubs Day Camp for kids ages 3-6. In this camp, kids will be encouraged to explore the wonders of nature through stories, games, crafts, and activities that will get them outdoors and moving. Every day will introduce a new topic to the campers while building on the knowledge from the day before with fun and informative lessons created by NorthWoods staff, Growing Up WILD, and the National Wildlife Federation. Our first day of camp jumps right into it with Forest Skills, where campers will get to know one another and the NorthWoods forest with a sensory walk along one of our trails, a few games, and an investigation of art and music using different parts of trees. On Tuesday, we have Playing in the Pond Day where our focus will be on exploring the NorthWoods pond – splashing around, catching the insects that call the water home, and learning about their life cycles. Next, we'll have Wildlife Wednesday, centered around all the cool animals that call Vermont Home. Through bug catching, birding, and plenty of games, campers will learn more about the animal they share their world with. Then on Thursday, our day will be filled with stories and songs by special guests from the Abenaki Nation, and finally, on Friday we will have an end-of-camp celebration featuring. Short hike through Brighton State Park and a beach day at Island Pond. All participants must be potty trained. **Day Camp Drop Off/Pick Up Monday-Friday, 9:00 am-2:30 pm**



## Earth Sisters Camp

**July 18 - 20 | Ages: 10 - 15 Overnight Camp **SOLD OUT****

**Cost: \$300**

NorthWoods' camp for girls and non-binary kids is back and ready to help campers build connections with one another and the natural world. Returning to the overnight roots of the past, this three-day camp will be dedicated to exploring local wonders, building survival and camp skills, learning about the natural communities around us, and discovering how to face new experiences and challenges as a team. Tuesday's focus will be on camp comradery – building our own full value contract, testing

out the NorthWoods low rope course elements, and hiking up to the glacial erratic to set-up camp. Wednesday will be all about water as we hike from the glacial erratic to Echo Lake and spend the day exploring the lake and perfecting paddling skills via canoe, before setting-up tents along the shoreline. Thursday, we'll travel back to NorthWoods for guided craft, animal investigations, and games before the final celebration at the pond. **Drop-off/Pick-up: Tuesday – Thursday, Drop-off 9:00 am Tuesday to pick-up Thursday, 4:00 pm.**

Horses are equal partners in this program, providing individuals with an entirely non-judgmental sentient being with whom to connect and bond. This partnership forms the foundation for opportunities to enhance self-awareness and/or re-pattern maladaptive behaviors, feelings, and attitudes. Children will enjoy horsemanship activities, confidence building activities, nature-based activities, fun and games. **It is requested each child pack a lunch and water bottle.**

Horse Camp is back and better than ever! This year there will be four weeks of Horse Camp, one for each week of Overnight Camp (Youth Camp Programs). Neal and Rebekah Perry will lead a team of volunteers and will offer fun activities with well trained horses. Activities include riding, driving, and good natural horsemanship methods. This program is offered to all levels of riders from those who have never ridden to advanced riders! Roughly half of the day is spent on horse activities Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. introductory program for beginners – those who have little to no experience riding. half of your camper's day will be spent learning how to ride and care for horses while the rest of the day will be spent enjoying camp activities.

Campers will take a look at how our forefathers expended and harnessed energy and how and why technologies changed during the time when the Industrial Revolution was beginning to take hold in northern Vermont, when Alexander Twilight resided in the Village (1829-1857). Through hands-on exploration and historic theatre related to renewable energy use through time and exploration of modern-day alternatives necessary for a changing world, campers will gain an understanding of how integrated as opposed to separate we are from the natural world. Camp favorites such as animal husbandry, outdoor cooking, theater, music, blacksmithing with theme explorations in solar cooking, wool as an insulator, water wheel experiments, hands-on lessons with the Vermont Energy Education Program and a Thursday field trip to Crystal Lake Falls Historic Association mill site – The Brick Kingdom. **Campers sign up for one or the other session, not both. ## Lamoille County Players – Children's Workshop Theatre SpongeBob Musical: Youth Edition

**Cost: \$200/2 weeks**

The Lamoille County Players is proud to announce the return of the Children's Theatre Workshop, which provides an opportunity for children between the ages of 9-15 to participate in a theatrical production.

The CTW will be a two-week, ten-day workshop. It is designed to introduce children to theatre, cultivate individual talents, and afford those with varied experience the opportunity for continued growth and personal challenge. During the course of the two-week camp, participants will collaborate on all aspects of theater production and performance. The workshop will conclude with 3 full performances!

Please note that while no previous theatre experience is necessary, LCP requires that the child have an interest in being involved in the workshop. The workshop will create a supportive and safe environment for the child to try something new; we only ask that they come willing to try and willing to say "Yes!"

The CTW will take place in Hyde Park Village, at the historic Hyde Park Opera House, from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm each day. The workshop schedule will address many areas of theatre: not only auditioning for parts (and contending with the casting choices that that are made) and rehearsing scenes, songs and dances, but also costuming, makeup, sets, props and more.

Each child should bring their own bag lunch and beverage each day, as well as a beach towel. Children should wear comfortable clothes that allow them to sit, lay and roll on the floor, as well as socks, and sneakers. Everything should be able to get dirty, and never hinder movement or imagination. Each child should also bring several pencils each day, and all items should be marked with the child's name.

Overnight camp includes all of the activities for Day Camp. On 3 days we either hike a mountain or canoe a river a short distance from the camp. We sometimes hike Belvidere Mountain or Jay Peak and canoe either the Missisquoi River or the Lamoille River. The longer days allow more time for rest and recreation; time to read a book, write in your journal or just visit with friends. Overnight Camp at the Bear Paw Pond base camp is an excellent way to prepare for bigger adventures in years ahead. Overnight campers stay in 2-person tents on tent platforms. Hearty, delicious meals are prepared by camp staff.

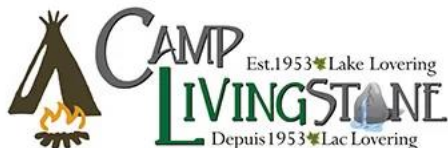

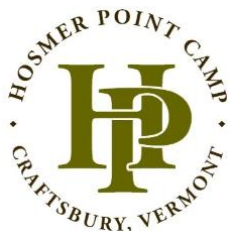

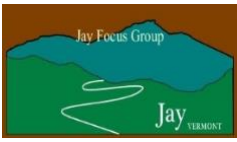
